
The “UBUKERARUGENDO IMBERE” project is a component of the decision under the financing agreement between the Government of Rwanda and the European Commission Support to Private Sector Development and Job creation in Rwanda. The overall objective of the “**UBUKERARUGENDO IMBERE Project**” is to improve market-oriented skills for the youth in the Tourism and Hospitality sector in Rwanda with the aim to make a meaningful contribution to the Government's objective of creating 214,000 new jobs per year to attain the Government’s target of 1,500,000 decent jobs created by 2024 as stated in the NST1.

In line with the above, the management of Rwanda TVET Board (RTB) through the above-named project, financed by the European Union, in collaboration with Rwanda Chamber of Tourism, is pleased to inform hospitality entities that it is conducting an Industrial Based Training/IBT for youth graduates in hospitality and tourism related courses for a period of nine (9) months. The trainings will take place in designated hotels and tour & travel companies.

TO HOST THE TRAININGS, COMPANIES SHOULD FULFILL THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Being ranked as 3 STAR Hotel in Kigali city and 1 star and above in other districts outside Kigali (This applies to accommodation establishments);
- ✓ Having in-company instructor or a designated employee ready to be trained by RTTI with a minimum of high school education qualification (A2);
- ✓ Should not be conducting similar trainings concurrently;
- ✓ Should be willing and committed to offer employment to candidates after completion of the trainings;
- ✓ For tour & travel companies, a tourism operating license from RDB and RTTA membership will be required.

Interested companies that fulfil the above requirements will write a letter expressing their interest to host the trainings and send it to info@rtb.gov.rw and dgatera@rtb.gov.rw not later than **10th March 2023**.
